






# 1.1 Updated CCADB Policy

## This policy update:

- → added clarifying language to "Section 5. Policies, Audits, and Practices"
- → stated CA Owners must disclose at least an authoritative English version of policy documents to the CCADB
- → added Audit Team Qualifications that are provided to the CCADB
- → (if required by a Root Store policy) defines the submission requirements for the CCADB Self-Assessment



# 1.2 Updated CCADB Self-Assessment

## This update included:


- → Instructions for the Cover Sheet (pointing to CCADB's "CA Hierarchy" report that can be used to enumerate CAs covered by this Self-Assessment.)
  - ◆ Note: this functionality was overviewed in the CCADB <u>update</u> at F2F 60
- → Mozilla Compliance Self-Assessment (now reflects MRSP Version 2.9 requirements)
- → Chrome Root Program Policy v. 1.5 Self-Assessment (from Version 1.4)
- → CCADB policy v 1.3 Self-Assessment (from Version 1.2.1)
- → TLS BRs v 2.0.2 (from Version 2.0.0)



# 1.3 Added Bylaws

This replaced and formalized the previous CCADB Steering Committee document that detailed Steering Committee Representative and Chairperson responsibilities.

→ Aligns with the CCADB Charter defined in the Linux Foundation Agreement




# 1.4 Updated CCADB Usage Terms

## 2.1 Audit Team Qualifications

## **Goal: Simplify & Consolidate**

- → Consolidate desired Audit Team Qualification attributes into a **single** policy (CCADB Policy)
- → All Audit Team Qualifications stored within the CCADB
- → Allow CA Owners to **easily** attach Audit Team Qualifications within the AUDITS tab

#### **CA Owners can:**

→ Upload an Audit Team Qualifications document

## **Root Store Operators can:**


→ Confirm Audit Team Qualifications within the same CCADB Case and keep all documentation within the CCADB
