
Facts about ETSI


- ∀ Audit covers period of time since last audit

Different players for different systems with different wording...

- Auditors, Auditing Companies, Conformity Assessment Bodies
- Standardization organization or assimilate (ISO, ETSI, CAB/Forum, Webtrust)
- Accreditation organization (IAF, EA, NAB)
- Scheme owner (Browsers, governmental entity, Trade association....)
- Other Stakeholder (ACAB'C, Webtrust)
- Certification system can be under accreditation or not

ACAB'C in short

- Association of CAB, all are private companies
- Members provide conformity assessment of TSP
 - Based on different standards (ISO, ETSI, CEN,CA/B Forum, Private initiative)
- Trusted by accreditation based on ISO standards (ISO 17065)
- Certification recognized in "IAF world"/EA
- ACAB'c members conduct certification activities all over the world and particularly in half of the European countries
- ACAB'c members qualified one third of all European qualified TSPs that are included in the EU Trusted List

ACAB'C in short

- Members are independent of software or service providers or any government
 - Independent companies
 - Taking certification decision (main difference with simple audit service)
- Impartiality
 - An independent comity to monitor activity
 - Accreditation by national body (NAB)
 - Requirements for publicly available information on TSP conformity and CAB practices (certification regulations)
- Competence
 - Competent auditors (requirements based on ISO 17021, 17065, EN 319 403)

ACAB'c full members

- LSTI: chairmanship
- TUV-IT GE : vice chairmanship
- KPMG
- Datenschutz
- 3 other members with on going application
- Potential other members: about 20 accredited CABs in EU

- Auditor's competence
- Type of audit and Audit Time
- Type of Reports
